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## A BILL

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to provide flexibility to school food authorities in establishing a price for paid school lunches.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “School Lunch Price  
5       Protection Act of 2015”.

6       **SEC. 2. PAID LUNCHES.**

7       Section 12(p) of the Richard B. Russell National  
8       School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1760(p)) is amended—

9               (1) in paragraph (2)—

1 (A) by striking subparagraph (A) and in-  
2 serting the following:

3 “(A) REQUIREMENT.—For each school  
4 year beginning on or after July 1, 2015, each  
5 school food authority that had a negative bal-  
6 ance of funds in the nonprofit school food serv-  
7 ice account of the school food authority for the  
8 previous school year shall establish a price for  
9 paid lunches in accordance with this sub-  
10 section.”;

11 (B) in subparagraph (B)(i), by inserting  
12 “described in subparagraph (A)” after “author-  
13 ity”; and

14 (C) in subparagraph (C)(i), by inserting  
15 “described in subparagraph (A)” after “author-  
16 ity”; and

17 (2) in paragraph (3)(A), by inserting “described  
18 in paragraph (2)(A)” after “authority”.

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
