A BILL

To take certain Federal land located in Tuolumne County, California, into trust for the benefit of the Tuolumne Band of Me-Wuk Indians, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND INTO TRUST.**

4 (a) FEDERAL LAND.—Subject to valid existing
5 rights, all right, title, and interest (including improve-

1 ments and appurtenances) of the United States in and to
2 the Federal land described in subsection (b) shall be held
3 in trust by the United States for the benefit of the
4 Tuolumne Band of Me-Wuk Indians for nongaming pur-
5 poses.

6 (b) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The land taken into trust
7 under subsection (a) is the approximately 80 acres of Fed-
8 eral land under the administrative jurisdiction of the
9 United States Forest Service, located in Tuolumne Coun-
10 ty, California, and described as follows:

11 (1) Southwest 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section
12 2, Township 1 North, Range 16 East.

13 (2) Northeast 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section
14 11, Township 1 North, Range 16 East *of the Mount*
15 *Diablo Meridian*.

16 (c) GAMING.—Class II and class III gaming (as those
17 terms are defined in section 4 of the Indian Gaming Regu-
18 latory Act (25 U.S.C. 2703)) shall not be permitted at
19 any time on the land taken into trust under subsection
20 (a).

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
