A BILL

To repeal the annual fee on health insurance providers enacted by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jobs and Premium
5 Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTING PATIENTS FROM HIGHER PREMIUMS.**

7 Section 9010 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
8 able Care Act (Public Law 111–148), as amended by sec-

1 tion 10905 of such Act and by section 1406 of the Health
2 Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public
3 Law 111–152), is repealed.

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
