A BILL

To protect communities from destructive Federal overreach
by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Local Zoning Decisions
5 Protection Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS.**

7 (a) HUD RULE.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, no Federal funds may be used to implement,
9 administer, or enforce the final rule of the Department
10 of Housing and Urban Development entitled “Affirma-

1 tively Furthering Fair Housing’’ (80 Fed. Reg. 42272
2 (July 16, 2015)).

3 (b) FEDERAL DATABASE.—Notwithstanding any
4 other provision of law, no Federal funds may be used to
5 design, build, maintain, utilize, or provide access to a Fed-
6 eral database of geospatial information on community ra-
7 cial disparities or disparities in access to affordable hous-
8 ing.

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
