Mr. KIRK (for himself and Mr. DURBIN) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of land of the Illiana Health
Care System of the Department of Veterans Affairs in
Danville, Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, DANVILLE, ILLINOIS.**

4 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans
6 Affairs may convey to the Danville Area Community
7 College of Danville, Illinois, all right, title, and inter-
8 est of the United States in and to certain real prop-
9 erty, including any improvements thereon, consisting
10 of approximately 0.6 acres known as “Building

1 Number 48”, which is part of the Illiana Health
2 Care System of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

3 (2) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The convey-
4 ance under paragraph (1) shall be subject to the
5 condition that the recipient accept the conveyed real
6 property in its condition at the time of the convey-
7 ance.

8 (b) CONSIDERATION FOR CONVEYANCE.—As consid-
9 eration for the conveyance under subsection (a), the Sec-
10 retary shall require the Danville Area Community College
11 to convey to the United States all right, title, and interest
12 of the Danville Area Community College in and to certain
13 real property, including any improvements thereon, con-
14 sisting of approximately 1.06 acres with a gazebo located
15 approximately 293 feet south of the Danville Area Com-
16 munity College Library Building, which is part of the
17 Danville Area Community College.

18 (c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
19 and legal description of the parcels of real property to be
20 conveyed under subsections (a) and (b) shall be deter-
21 mined by surveys satisfactory to the Secretary.

22 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
23 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
24 tions in connection with the conveyances under subsections

- 1 (a) and (b) as the Secretary considers appropriate to pro-
- 2 tect the interests of the United States.
