A BILL

To amend section 320301 of title 54, United States Code, to modify the authority of the President of the United States to declare national monuments, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO AUTHORITY TO DECLARE NA-**
4 **TIONAL MONUMENTS.**

5 Section 320301 of title 54, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(e) EFFECTIVE DATE.—A proclamation or reserva-
2 tion under subsection (a) or (b) shall expire 3 years after
3 proclaimed or reserved unless specifically approved by—

4 “(1) a Federal law enacted after the date of the
5 proclamation or reservation; and

6 “(2) a State law, for each State where the land
7 covered by the proclamation or reservation is lo-
8 cated, enacted after the date of the proclamation or
9 reservation.”.

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
