To provide for a technical change to the Medicare long-term care hospital moratorium exception.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CHANGE TO THE MEDICARE LONG-**
4 **TERM CARE HOSPITAL MORATORIUM EXCEP-**
5 **TION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 114(d) of the Medicare,
7 Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C.
8 1395ww note), as amended by sections 3106(b) and
9 10312(b) of Public Law 111–148, section 1206(b)(2) of
10 the Pathway for SGR Reform Act of 2013 (division B of

1 Public Law 113–67), and section 112 of the Protecting
2 Access to Medicare Act of 2014 (Public Law 113–93), is
3 amended, in paragraph (7), by striking “The moratorium
4 under paragraph (1)(A)” and inserting “Any moratorium
5 under paragraph (1)” in the matter preceding subpara-
6 graph (A).

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
9 ment of section 112 of the Protecting Access to Medicare
10 Act of 2014 (Public Law 113–93).
