A BILL

To amend the Fair Credit Reporting Act to clarify the ability to request consumer reports in certain cases to establish and enforce child support payments and awards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Assist-
5 ance Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUESTS FOR CONSUMER REPORTS BY STATE OR**
2 **LOCAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT**
3 **AGENCIES.**

4 Section 604(a)(4) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act
5 (15 U.S.C. 1681b(a)(4)) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or deter-
7 mining the appropriate level of such payments” and
8 inserting “, determining the appropriate level of
9 such payments, or enforcing a child support order,
10 award, agreement, or judgment”;

11 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

12 (A) by striking “paternity” and inserting
13 “parentage”; and

14 (B) by adding “and” at the end;

15 (3) by striking subparagraph (C); and

16 (4) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as sub-
17 paragraph (C).

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
