A BILL

To require the Council of Inspectors General on Integrity
and Efficiency to submit to Congress a report on Inspector
General mandates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Inspector General
5 Mandates Reporting Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF INSPECTORS GEN-**
 2 **ERAL.**

3 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “report-
 4 ing requirement” means a report that an Office of Inspec-
 5 tor General is required to complete under the Inspector
 6 General Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) or any other provi-
 7 sion of law.

8 (b) REPORT BY INSPECTORS GENERAL TO CIGIE.—
 9 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment of this
 10 Act, each Office of Inspector General shall submit to the
 11 Council of Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency
 12 a report, which—

13 (1) shall include a list of each reporting re-
 14 quirement for the Office of Inspector General; and

15 (2) may include a list of each reporting require-
 16 ment that the Office of Inspector General rec-
 17 ommends should be modified or repealed.

18 (c) REPORT BY CIGIE TO CONGRESS.—Not later
 19 than 60 days after the date on which the Council of In-
 20 spectors General on Integrity and Efficiency receives the
 21 reports required to be submitted under subsection ~~(a)~~ (b),
 22 the Council shall submit to Congress a report, which—

23 (1) shall include—

24 (A) a list of each reporting requirement
 25 that is common to more than 1 Office of In-
 26 spector General; and

1 (B) a list, by Office of Inspector General,
2 of each reporting requirement that is unique to
3 that Office of Inspector General; and

4 (2) may include recommendations for reporting
5 requirements that should be modified or repealed.

6 (d) FORM.—Each report submitted under this section
7 shall be in unclassified form, but may include a classified
8 annex.

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
