2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SIDNEY OLSIN SMITH, JR. FEDERAL BUILDING**

4 **AND UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building and United
6 States courthouse located at 121 Spring Street SE in
7 Gainesville, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Sidney Olsin Smith, Jr. Federal Building and United
2 States Courthouse”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the Federal building and United States court-
6 house referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be
7 a reference to the “Sidney Olsin Smith, Jr. Federal Build-
8 ing and United States Courthouse”.
