To expand eligibility for hospital care and medical services under section 101 of the Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014 to include veterans who are age 75 or older, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY UNDER THE**
4 **CHOICE PROGRAM TO INCLUDE VETERANS**
5 **AGE 75 OR OLDER.**

6 Section 101(b)(2) of the Veterans Access, Choice,
7 and Accountability Act of 2014 (Public Law 113–146; 38
8 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—

- 1 (1) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking “; or”
2 and inserting a semicolon;
- 3 (2) in subparagraph (D)(ii)(II)(dd), by striking
4 the period at the end and inserting “; or”; and
- 5 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 paragraph:
7 “(E) is age 75 or older.”.

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
