A BILL

To permit the Attorney General to authorize a temporary transfer of funds from Department of Justice accounts in the amount necessary to restore Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture Program equitable sharing payments to participating law enforcement agencies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Support Our Brave
5 Law Enforcement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TRANSFERS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
3 sion of law, the Attorney General may authorize a tem-
4 porary transfer of funds from accounts of the Department
5 of Justice in the amount necessary to restore Department
6 of Justice Asset Forfeiture Program equitable sharing
7 payments to participating law enforcement agencies.

8 (b) RETURN.—The Attorney General shall return to
9 accounts of the Department of Justice the specific
10 amounts transferred as soon as sufficient funds become
11 available in the Department of Justice Assets Forfeiture
12 Fund.

13 (c) REPORT.—The Attorney General shall submit to
14 the Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Ap-
15 propriations of the Senate and the Committee on the Judi-
16 ciary and the Committee on Appropriations of the House
17 of Representatives a report on any transfer made under
18 subsection (a).

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
