Mr. CARDIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the Drinking Water State
Revolving Fund and the Clean Water State Revolving Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Firm, Unwavering Na-
5 tional Dedication to Water Act” or the “FUND Water
6 Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND.**

8 Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42
9 U.S.C. 300j–12) is amended by striking subsection (m)
10 and inserting the following:

1 “(m) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
 2 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this sec-
 3 tion—

4 “(1) \$3,130,000,000 for fiscal year 2017;

5 “(2) \$3,600,000,000 for fiscal year 2018;

6 “(3) \$4,140,000,000 for fiscal year 2019;

7 “(4) \$4,800,000,000 for fiscal year 2020; and

8 “(5) \$5,500,000,000 for fiscal year 2021.”.

9 **SEC. 3. CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND.**

10 Title VI of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act
 11 (33 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.) is amended by striking section
 12 607 and inserting the following:

13 **“SEC. 607. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

14 “There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out
 15 this title—

16 “(1) \$5,180,000,000 for fiscal year 2017;

17 “(2) \$5,960,000,000 for fiscal year 2018;

18 “(3) \$6,850,000,000 for fiscal year 2019;

19 “(4) \$7,880,000,000 for fiscal year 2020; and

20 “(5) \$9,060,000,000 for fiscal year 2021.”.

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
