# S. 2600

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## A BILL

To amend the Military Selective Service Act to provide that any modification to the duty to register for purposes of the Military Selective Service Act may be made only through an Act of Congress, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION TO DUTY TO REGISTER FOR**  
2 **PURPOSES OF THE MILITARY SELECTIVE**  
3 **SERVICE ACT ONLY THROUGH AN ACT OF**  
4 **CONGRESS.**

5 (a) MODIFICATION ONLY THROUGH ACT OF CON-  
6 GRESS.—Section 3 of the Military Selective Service Act  
7 (50 U.S.C. 3802) is amended by adding at the end the  
8 following new subsection:

9 “(c) Any modification or change to the persons sub-  
10 ject to the duty to register pursuant to this section may  
11 be made only through an Act of Congress.”.

12 (b) PROHIBITION ON COURT JURISDICTION OF  
13 CLAIMS REGARDING CLASS OF PERSONS WITH DUTY TO  
14 REGISTER.—No court created by Act of Congress shall  
15 have any jurisdiction, and the Supreme Court shall have  
16 no appellate jurisdiction, to hear or decide any question  
17 or claim, whether filed before, on, or after the date of en-  
18 actment of this Act, pertaining to the interpretation of,  
19 or the validity under the Constitution of, the class of per-  
20 sons subject to the duty to register for purposes of the  
21 Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. 3801 et seq.).

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
