Mr. SULLIVAN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a Battle of Midway 75th
Anniversary Semipostal Stamp.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BATTLE OF MIDWAY 75TH ANNIVERSARY**

4 **SEMIPOSTAL STAMP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—In order to afford a convenient
6 way for members of the public to contribute to the celebra-
7 tion of the 75th anniversary of the Battle of Midway, the
8 United States Postal Service shall issue a semipostal
9 stamp in accordance with the provisions of this section.

1 Such semipostal stamp shall be known as the “Battle of
2 Midway 75th Anniversary Semipostal Stamp”.

3 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The issuance and sale of the
5 Battle of Midway 75th Anniversary Semipostal
6 Stamp shall be governed by the provisions of section
7 416 of title 39, United States Code, and regulations
8 issued under that section, subject to the require-
9 ments of this subsection.

10 (2) DURATION.—The Battle of Midway 75th
11 Anniversary Semipostal Stamp shall be made avail-
12 able to the public for a period of 1 year, beginning
13 not later than June 4, 2017.

14 (3) DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS.—All amounts
15 becoming available from the sale of the Battle of
16 Midway 75th Anniversary Semipostal Stamp (as de-
17 termined under section 416(d) of title 39, United
18 States Code) shall be transferred to the Department
19 of Defense, for the purpose described in subsection
20 (a) of this section, through payments which shall be
21 made not less frequently than twice a year.

22 (c) LIMITATION.—For purposes of section 416 of title
23 39, United States Code (including any regulation pre-
24 scribed under subsection (e)(1)(C) of that section), the
25 semipostal stamp issued under this Act shall not apply to

1 any limitation relating to whether more than 1 semipostal
2 stamp may be offered for sale at the same time.

3 (d) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the
4 term “semipostal stamp” has the meaning given the term
5 “semipostal” in section 416(a)(1) of title 39, United
6 States Code.

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
