To amend title 32, United States Code, to specify the availability of certain funds provided by the Department of Defense to States for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS PROVIDED BY DE-**
4 **PARTMENT OF DEFENSE TO STATES FOR**
5 **DRUG INTERDICTION AND COUNTER-DRUG**
6 **ACTIVITIES.**

7 Section 112(a) of title 32, United States Code, is
8 amended—

1 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
2 (3) as subparagraphs (A) through (C), respectively;
3 (2) by striking “The Secretary” and inserting
4 “(1) The Secretary”; and
5 (3) by adding at the end the following new
6 paragraph:
7 “(2) Funds provided under this subsection shall re-
8 main available for obligation or expenditure for three fiscal
9 years.”.
