A BILL

To provide that the pueblo of Santa Clara may lease for
99 years certain restricted land, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF PUEBLO OF SANTA CLARA**
2 **LAND ELIGIBLE FOR 99-YEAR LEASE.**

3 Subsection (a) of the first section of the Act of Au-
4 gust 9, 1955 (commonly known as the “Long-Term Leas-
5 ing Act”) (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended—

6 (1) by striking “Indians,,” and inserting “Indi-
7 ans,”;

8 (2) by inserting “Ohkay Owingeh pueblo,” after
9 “Cochiti,”;

10 (3) by inserting “the pueblo of Santa Clara,”
11 after “Pojoaque,”;

12 (4) by striking “the the lands” and inserting
13 “the land”;

14 (5) by striking “lands held in trust for the
15 Pueblo of Santa Clara,”; and

16 (6) by striking “lands held in trust for Ohkay
17 Owingeh Pueblo”.

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
