To treat all controlled substance analogues, other than chemical substances subject to the Toxic Substances Control Act, as controlled substances in schedule I regardless of whether they are intended for human consumption.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Illegal Synthetic Drug
5 Safety Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ANA-**
2 **LOGUES.**

3 Section 203 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
4 U.S.C. 813) is amended by striking “shall, to the extent
5 intended for human consumption,” and inserting the fol-
6 lowing: “that is not a chemical substance subject to the
7 Toxic Substances Control Act (15 U.S.C. 2601 et seq.)
8 shall”.

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
