A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide an additional tool to prevent certain frauds against veterans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Crimes
5 Against Veterans Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL TOOL TO PREVENT CERTAIN FRAUDS**
7 **AGAINST VETERANS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 47 of title 18, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 **“§ 1041. Fraud regarding veterans’ benefits**

2 “(a) Whoever knowingly engages in any scheme or
3 artifice to defraud an individual of veterans’ benefits, or
4 in connection with obtaining veteran’s benefits for that in-
5 dividual, shall be fined under this title, imprisoned for not
6 more than 5 years, or both.

7 “(b) In this section—

8 “(1) the term ‘veteran’ has the meaning given
9 that term in section 101 of title 38; and

10 “(2) the term ‘veterans’ benefits’ means any
11 benefit provided under Federal law for a veteran or
12 a dependent or survivor of a veteran.”.

13 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
14 for chapter 47 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
15 by adding at the end the following new item:

“1041. Fraud regarding veterans’ benefits.”.
