A BILL

To transfer certain items from the United States Munitions
List to the Commerce Control List.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Export Control Reform
5 Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPORT CONTROLS ON CERTAIN ITEMS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 38(f) of
8 the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2778(f)) or any
9 other provision of law, all items described in subsection
10 (b) that are on the United States Munitions List and con-

1 trolled under section 38 of the Arms Export Control Act
2 (22 U.S.C. 2778) on the date of the enactment of this
3 Act shall be transferred to the Commerce Control List of
4 dual-use items in the Export Administration Regulations
5 (15 C.F.R. part 730 et seq.).

6 (b) TRANSFERRED ITEMS.—The items referred to in
7 subsection (a) are the following:

8 (1) Non-automatic and semi-automatic fire-
9 arms, including all rifles, carbines, pistols, revolvers
10 and shotguns.

11 (2) Non-automatic and non-semi-automatic ri-
12 fles, carbines, revolvers, or pistols of a caliber great-
13 er than .50 inches (12.7 mm) up to and including
14 .72 inches (18.0 mm).

15 (3) Ammunition for such firearms excluding
16 caseless ammunition.

17 (4) Silencers, mufflers, and sound and flash
18 suppressors.

19 (5) Rifle scopes.

20 (6) Barrels, cylinders, receivers (frames), or
21 complete breech mechanisms.

22 (7) Related components, parts, accessories, at-
23 tachments, tooling, and equipment for any articles
24 listed in paragraphs (1) through (6).

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
2 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act and
3 shall not apply to any export license issued before such
4 effective date or to any export license application made
5 under the United States Munitions List before such effec-
6 tive date.
