AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out
a major medical facility project in Reno, Nevada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN MAJOR MEDICAL**
2 **FACILITY PROJECTS OF THE DEPARTMENT**
3 **OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
5 may carry out the following major medical facility
6 projects, with each project to be carried out in an amount
7 not to exceed the amount specified for that project:

8 (1) Seismic, life safety, and utilities upgrades
9 and expansion of clinical services in Reno, Nevada,
10 in an amount not to exceed \$213,800,000.

11 (2) Seismic corrections to the mental health
12 and community living center in Long Beach, Cali-
13 fornia, in an amount not to exceed \$317,300,000.

14 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
15 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Veterans
16 Affairs for fiscal year 2017 or the year in which funds
17 are appropriated for the Construction, Major Projects, ac-
18 count \$531,100,000 for the projects authorized in sub-
19 section (a).

20 (c) LIMITATION.—The projects authorized in sub-
21 section (a) may only be carried out using—

22 (1) funds appropriated for fiscal year 2017 or
23 the year in which funds are appropriated for the
24 Construction, Major Projects, account pursuant to
25 the authorization of appropriations in subsection (b);

1 (2) funds available for Construction, Major
2 Projects, for a fiscal year before fiscal year 2017
3 that remain available for obligation;

4 (3) funds available for Construction, Major
5 Projects, for a fiscal year after fiscal year 2017 that
6 remain available for obligation;

7 (4) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
8 Projects, for fiscal year 2017 for a category of activ-
9 ity not specific to a project;

10 (5) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
11 Projects, for a fiscal year before fiscal year 2017 for
12 a category of activity not specific to a project; and

13 (6) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
14 Projects, for a fiscal year after fiscal year 2017 for
15 a category of activity not specific to a project.
