A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Senate Campaign Dis-
5 closure Parity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FILING BY SENATE CANDIDATES WITH COMMIS-**
2 **SION.**

3 Section 302(g) of the Federal Election Campaign Act
4 of 1971 (52 U.S.C. 30102(g)) is amended to read as fol-
5 lows:

6 “(g) FILING WITH THE COMMISSION.—All des-
7 ignations, statements, and reports required to be
8 filed under this Act shall be filed with the Commis-
9 sion.”.

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
