Ms. WARREN (for herself, Mr. RUBIO, Mr. MARKEY, Ms. AYOTTE, Mrs. SHAHEEN, Mr. TOOMEY, Mr. BROWN, and Mr. MENENDEZ) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

A BILL

To direct the Architect of the Capitol to place in the United States Capitol a chair honoring American Prisoners of War/Missing in Action.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National POW/MIA
5 Remembrance Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

8 (1) In recent years, commemorative chairs hon-
9 oring American Prisoners of War/Missing in Action

1 have been placed in prominent locations across the
2 United States.

3 (2) The United States Capitol is an appropriate
4 location to place a commemorative chair honoring
5 American Prisoners of War/Missing in Action.

6 **SEC. 3. PLACEMENT OF A CHAIR IN THE UNITED STATES**
7 **CAPITOL HONORING AMERICAN PRISONERS**
8 **OF WAR/MISSING IN ACTION.**

9 (a) OBTAINING CHAIR.—The Architect of the Capitol
10 shall enter into an agreement to obtain a chair featuring
11 the logo of the National League of POW/MIA Families
12 under such terms and conditions as the Architect con-
13 siderers appropriate and consistent with applicable law.

14 (b) PLACEMENT.—Not later than 2 years after the
15 date of enactment of this Act, the Architect shall place
16 the chair obtained under subsection (a) in a suitable per-
17 manent location in the United States Capitol.

18 **SEC. 4. FUNDING.**

19 (a) DONATIONS.—The Architect of the Capitol
20 may—

21 (1) enter into an agreement with any organiza-
22 tion described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
23 Revenue Code of 1986 that is exempt from taxation
24 under section 501(a) of that Code to solicit private
25 donations to carry out the purposes of this Act; and

1 (2) accept donations of funds, property, and
2 services to carry out the purposes of this Act.

3 (b) COSTS.—All costs incurred in carrying out the
4 purposes of this Act shall be paid for with private dona-
5 tions received under subsection (a).

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
