A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Treasury to convene a panel of citizens to make a recommendation to the Secretary regarding the likeness of a woman on the twenty dollar bill, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Women on the Twenty
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CITIZENS PANEL RELATING TO THE LIKENESS OF A**
2 **WOMAN TO BE INCLUDED ON THE FACE OF**
3 **THE \$20 FEDERAL RESERVE NOTE.**

4 The 8th undesignated paragraph of section 16 of the
5 Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 418) is amended by add-
6 ing at the end the following new sentence: “The Secretary
7 of the Treasury shall convene a panel of private citizens
8 of the United States to advise and make recommendations
9 to the Secretary regarding the likeness of a woman to ap-
10 pear on the face of \$20 Federal reserve notes. In carrying
11 out the requirements of the preceding sentence, each of
12 the Secretary and the panel shall consider and weigh input
13 provided by the American people.”.

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
