Authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center for a ceremony to commemorate the 150th Anniversary of the ratification of the 13th Amendment.

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY**
4 **TO COMMEMORATE THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY**
5 **OF THE RATIFICATION OF THE 13TH AMEND-**
6 **MENT.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on Decem-
9 ber 8, 2015, for a ceremony to commemorate the 150th
10 Anniversary of the ratification of the 13th Amendment to
11 the Constitution of the United States, which abolished
12 slavery in the United States.

1 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
2 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
3 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as may
4 be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol.
