Mr. McCONNELL submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 on any day from Thursday, February 11, 2016, through
4 Saturday, February 20, 2016, on a motion offered pursu-
5 ant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00
7 noon on Monday, February 22, 2016, or such other time
8 on that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader
9 or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
10 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this

1 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
2 when the House adjourns on any legislative day from Fri-
3 day, February 12, 2016, through Tuesday, February 16,
4 2016, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
5 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
6 adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 23, 2016,
7 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
8 3 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. (a) The Majority Leader of the Senate or his
10 designee, after concurrence with the Minority Leader of
11 the Senate, shall notify the Members of the Senate to reas-
12 semble at such place and time as he may designate if, in
13 his opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.

14 (b) After reassembling pursuant to subsection (a),
15 when the Senate adjourns on a motion offered pursuant
16 to this subsection by its Majority Leader or his designee,
17 the Senate shall again stand adjourned pursuant to the
18 first section of this concurrent resolution.

19 SEC. 3. (a) The Speaker or his designee, after con-
20 sultation with the Minority Leader of the House, shall no-
21 tify the Members of the House to reassemble at such place
22 and time as he may designate if, in his opinion, the public
23 interest shall warrant it.

24 (b) After reassembling pursuant to subsection (a),
25 when the House adjourns on a motion offered pursuant

- 1 to this subsection by its Majority Leader or his designee,
- 2 the House shall again stand adjourned pursuant to the
- 3 first section of this concurrent resolution.
