Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and
referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the disapproval of the proposed foreign military
sale to the Government of Pakistan of F-16 Block 52
aircraft.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any
4 of the following proposed sales to the Government of Paki-
5 stan (described in the certification Transmittal No. 15-
6 80, sent to the Speaker of the House of Representatives
7 and the chairman of the Committee on Foreign Relations
8 of the Senate pursuant to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms
9 Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1))) on February
10 11, 2016, is hereby prohibited:

1 (1) The proposed sale of eight (8) F-16 Block
2 52 aircraft (two (2) C and six (6) D models), with
3 the F100-PW-229 increased performance engine
4 (Transmittal Numbered 15-80).

5 (2) The proposed sale of fourteen (14) Joint
6 Helmet Mounted Cueing Systems (JHMCS), and re-
7 lated defense articles and defense services (Trans-
8 mittal Numbered 15-80).

9 (3) The proposed sale of eight (8) AN/APG-
10 68(V)9 radars, and related defense articles and de-
11 fense services (Transmittal Numbered 15-80).

12 (4) The proposed sale of eight (8) ALQ-
13 211(V)9 Advanced Integrated Defensive Electronic
14 Warfare Suites (AIDEWS), and related defense arti-
15 cles and defense services (Transmittal Numbered
16 15-80).

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
