resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

Amending rule XXII of the Standing Rules of the Senate
to limit debate on motions to proceed.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. LIMITING DEBATE ON MOTIONS TO PROCEED**

3 **UNDER RULE XXII.**

4 Rule XXII of the Standing Rules of the Senate is
5 amended by—

6 (1) redesignating paragraphs (2) and (3) as
7 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “2. Other than a motion made during the first
2 2 hours of a new legislative day, as described in
3 paragraph 2 of rule VIII, consideration of a motion
4 to proceed to the consideration of any debatable
5 matter, including consideration of any debatable mo-
6 tion or appeal in connection therewith, shall be lim-
7 ited to not more than 2 hours, to be divided equally
8 between the majority and the minority. This para-
9 graph shall not apply to motions considered non-
10 debatable by the Senate pursuant to rule or prece-
11 dent.”.
