RESOLUTION

Congratulating the administration, staff, students, and alumni of Roosevelt University on the occasion of the 70th anniversary of the University.

Whereas on April 17, 2015, Roosevelt University, located in Chicago, Illinois, will celebrate the 70th anniversary of the founding of the University on April 17, 1945;

Whereas Roosevelt University has graduated more than 95,000 students who have become leaders in their professions and careers, including the first African-American mayor of Chicago, Harold Washington;

Whereas Roosevelt University was founded at a time when most institutions of higher education in the United States did not enroll large numbers of minority or immigrant students;

Whereas Roosevelt University became 1 of the first colleges
in the United States to admit all qualified students, re-
gardless of race, religion, or national origin;

Whereas throughout its history, Roosevelt University has al-
ways remained true to the values of inclusiveness, oppor-
tunity, and social justice; and

Whereas today, Roosevelt remains 1 of the most diverse uni-
versities in the Midwest: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

4 casion of the 70th anniversary of the University; and
