8 “SECTION 1. The first article of amendment does not
9 apply to the political speech of any corporation, partner-
10 ship, business trust, association, or other business organi-
11 zation with respect to the making of contributions, ex-
12 penditures, or other disbursements of funds in connection
13 with public elections.

19 “SECTION 3. A State shall have power to set limits
20 on the amount of contributions that may be accepted by,
21 and the amount of expenditures that may be made by, in
22 support of, or in opposition to, a candidate for nomination
23 for election to, or for election to, State or local office.

1 “SECTION 4. Congress shall have power to implement
2 and enforce this article by appropriate legislation.”.
