A BILL

To exempt certain veterans and other individuals from the
application of the hiring freeze.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Federal Hir-
5 ing Protection Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM THE HIRING FREEZE FOR CER-**
2 **TAIN VETERANS AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS.**

3 Notwithstanding the memorandum titled “Presi-
4 dential Memorandum Regarding the Hiring Freeze” pub-
5 lished on January 23, 2017, or any other substantially
6 similar memorandum, Executive order, or other action by
7 the President to prevent a department or agency of the
8 Federal Government from filling vacant Federal civilian
9 employee positions or creating new such positions, a de-
10 partment or agency may appoint an individual to a posi-
11 tion covered by such memorandum if the position will be
12 filled by an individual who is a preference eligible, as that
13 term is defined in section 2108(3) of title 5, United States
14 Code.

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
