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## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Homeland Security from granting a work authorization to an alien found to have been unlawfully present in the United States.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Equal Protection for  
5       American Workers Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN WORK AUTHORIZA-**  
7       **TIONS.**

8       Effective beginning on the date of the enactment of  
9       this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security is prohibited

1 from granting a work authorization to an alien who has  
2 been finally determined, in a valid immigration proceeding  
3 during which due process was afforded, to have been at  
4 any time unlawfully present in the United States.

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
