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## A BILL

To suspend assistance to countries denying or delaying accepting aliens ordered removed from the United States, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF ASSISTANCE TO COUNTRIES**  
4                       **DENYING OR DELAYING ACCEPTING ALIENS**  
5                       **ORDERED REMOVED.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—The President shall suspend the  
7       provision of assistance under any provision of law with re-  
8       spect to each country on the list required by subsection  
9       (b).

1       (b) LIST OF COUNTRIES.—Not later than 180 days  
2 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually  
3 thereafter, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall sub-  
4 mit to Congress a list of each country that the Secretary  
5 determines denies or unreasonably delays accepting an  
6 alien who is a citizen, subject, national, or resident of that  
7 country after the Secretary asks whether the government  
8 will accept the alien under section 241 of the Immigration  
9 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1251).

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
