Mr. KING of Iowa (for himself and Mr. GOHMERT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To terminate the EB–5 program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF EB–5 PROGRAM.**

4 (a) REPEAL OF PROVISIONS.—Effective on the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, the following provisions are
6 repealed:

7 (1) Section 203(b)(5) of the Immigration and
8 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(b)(5)).

9 (2) Section 204(a)(1)(H) of the Immigration
10 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1154(a)(1)(H)).

11 (3) Section 216A of the Immigration and Na-
12 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1186b).

1 (4) Section 610 of the Departments of Com-
2 merce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Re-
3 lated Agencies Appropriations Act, 1993 (8 U.S.C.
4 1153 note).

5 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Beginning on the date of the
6 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
7 rity—

8 (1) shall cease to accept petitions and applica-
9 tions under any authority repealed under subsection
10 (a); and

11 (2) shall dismiss all pending petitions and appli-
12 cations described in paragraph (1).

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
