A BILL

To provide that no additional Federal funds may be made
available for National Heritage Areas, and for other pur-
poses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End NHA Earmarking
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NO ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS FOR NATIONAL**
7 **HERITAGE AREAS.**

8 (a) PROHIBITION ON FUTURE FUNDING.—No Fed-
9 eral funds may be made available for the National Herit-

1 age Partnership Program or for any National Heritage
2 Area.

3 (b) SAVINGS.—Subsection (a) shall not affect the
4 availability of Federal funds made appropriated or other-
5 wise made available before the date of the enactment of
6 this Act.

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
