Mr. RODNEY DAVIS of Illinois (for himself and Mr. PETERS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To require the Administration of General Services to issue guidance relating to the procurement of reclaimed refrigerants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Refrigerant
5 Management and Stewardship Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROMOTING USE OF RECLAIMED REFRIGERANTS IN**
7 **FEDERAL FACILITIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
9 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of

1 General Services shall issue guidance relating to the pro-
2 curement of reclaimed refrigerants to service existing
3 equipment in Federal facilities.

4 (b) PREFERENCE.—The guidance issued under sub-
5 section (a) shall give preference to the use of reclaimed
6 refrigerants if—

7 (1) the refrigerant has been reclaimed by an in-
8 dividual or entity that is certified under the labora-
9 tory certification program of the Air Conditioning,
10 Heating, and Refrigeration Institute; and

11 (2) the price of the reclaimed refrigerant does
12 not exceed the price of a newly manufactured refrig-
13 erant.

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
