To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to expand the ability of trade associations to solicit contributions from the stockholders and executive or administrative personnel of their member corporations, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prior Approval Reform
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANDING ABILITY OF TRADE ASSOCIATIONS TO**
2 **SOLICIT CONTRIBUTIONS FROM MEMBER**
3 **CORPORATIONS.**

4 (a) SOLICITATIONS.—Section 316(b)(4)(D) of the
5 Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (52 U.S.C.
6 30118(b)(4)(D)) is amended by striking “to the extent
7 that” and all that follows and inserting a period.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall apply to solicitations made on or after
10 January 1, 2018.

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
