A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to provide exclusive original jurisdiction to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia of certain cases relating to the powers of the Executive, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Assigning Proper
5 Placement of Executive Action Lawsuits Act” or the “AP-
6 PEAL Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSIVE ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OVER CER-**
2 **TAIN CASES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 85 of title 28, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 **“§ 1370. Claims relating to certain actions of the exec-**
7 **utive.**

8 “The United States District Court for the District
9 of Columbia shall have exclusive original jurisdiction to
10 hear and determine any claim that arises in a case or con-
11 troversy as to an Executive order, action, or memo-
12 randum.”.

13 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
14 at the beginning of chapter 85 of title 28, United States
15 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
16 item:

“1370. Claims relating to certain actions of the executive.”.
