Mr. HUFFMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To prohibit the Export-Import Bank of the United States from providing financial support for certain high carbon intensity energy projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Standing Against
5 Dirty Diplomacy Act” or the “SADD Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON EXPORT-IMPORT BANK SUPPORT**
 2 **FOR CERTAIN HIGH CARBON INTENSITY EN-**
 3 **ERGY PROJECTS.**

4 Section 2(b) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
 5 (12 U.S.C. 635(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
 6 following:

7 “(14) PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT FOR CERTAIN
 8 HIGH CARBON INTENSITY ENERGY PROJECTS.—

9 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Bank shall not guar-
 10 antee, insure, extend credit, or participate in the ex-
 11 tension of credit in connection with the purchase or
 12 sale of any good or service for a high carbon inten-
 13 sity project.

14 “(B) HIGH CARBON INTENSITY PROJECT DE-
 15 FINED.—In subparagraph (A), the term ‘high car-
 16 bon intensity project’ means a project that—

17 “(i) is designed to generate electricity; and

18 “(ii) if completed, would produce at least
 19 500 grams of carbon dioxide per kilowatt-hour
 20 of electricity generated by the project.”.

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
