Mr. Richmond introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

## A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to prohibit inclusion of Social Security account numbers on Medicare cards, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF INCLUSION OF SOCIAL SECURITY ACCOUNT NUMBERS ON MEDICARE

CARDS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 205(c)(2)(C) of the Social

Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(c)(2)(C)) is amended by adding at the end the following new clause:

"(xiv) The Secretary of Health and

Human Services, in consultation with the

1 Commissioner of Social Security, shall es-2 tablish cost-effective procedures to ensure 3 that a Social Security account number (or derivative thereof) is not displayed, coded, or embedded on the Medicare card issued 6 to an individual who is entitled to benefits 7 under part A of title XVIII or enrolled 8 under part B of title XVIII and that any 9 other identifier displayed on such card is 10 not identifiable as a Social Security ac-11 count number (or derivative thereof).".

- 12 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—In implementing clause (xiv)
  13 of section 205(c)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act (42
  14 U.S.C. 405(c)(2)(C)), as added by subsection (a), the Sec15 retary of Health and Human Services shall do the fol16 lowing:
- 17 (1) IN GENERAL.—Establish a cost-effective 18 process that involves the least amount of disruption 19 to, as well as necessary assistance for, Medicare 20 beneficiaries and health care providers, such as a 21 process that provides such beneficiaries with access 22 to assistance through a toll-free telephone number 23 and provides outreach to providers.
- 24 (2) Consideration of Medicare Bene-25 Ficiary identified.—Consider implementing a

process, similar to the process involving Railroad Retirement Board beneficiaries, under which a Medicare beneficiary identifier which is not a Social Security account number (or derivative thereof) is used external to the Department of Health and Human Services and is convertible over to a Social Security account number (or derivative thereof) for use internal to such Department and the Social Security Administration.

## (c) Effective Date.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—Clause (xiv) of section 205(c)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(c)(2)(C)), as added by subsection (a), shall apply with respect to Medicare cards issued on and after an effective date specified by the Secretary of Health and Human Services, but in no case shall such effective date be later than January 1, 2018.
- (2) Reissuance.—The Secretary shall provide for the reissuance of Medicare cards that comply with the requirements of such clause not later than January 1, 2019.
