A BILL

To extend the duration of Military OneSource Program services for members of the Armed Forces upon their separation or retirement from the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “More for Veterans
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDED DURATION OF AVAILABILITY OF MILI-**
2 **TARY ONESOURCE PROGRAM SERVICES FOR**
3 **MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES UPON**
4 **THEIR SEPARATION OR RETIREMENT.**

5 The Secretary of Defense shall ensure that retired
6 and honorably discharged members of the Armed Forces,
7 including members medically discharged, separated, or on
8 the temporary disability retirement list, and their imme-
9 diate family remain eligible for services under the Military
10 OneSource Program for at least one year after the end
11 of the member's tour of service, the member's retirement
12 date, or the member's separation date, as the case may
13 be.

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
