3 **SECTION 1. DIVERSITY OF CITIZENSHIP JURISDICTION.**

4 Section 1332 of title 28, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(f) For the purposes of this section, diversity of citi-
7 zenship exists if at least one party adverse to any other

- 1 party to the civil action does not share the same citizen-
- 2 ship with that adverse party.”.
