3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Samoa In-
5 vestment Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF UNITED STATES NATIONALS AS ELI-**
2 **GIBLE EMPLOYEES.**

3 Section 203(b)(5)(A)(ii) of the Immigration and Na-
4 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(b)(5)(A)(ii)) is amended by
5 inserting after “not fewer than 10 United States citizens”
6 the following: “, United States nationals,”.
