To require that in a notice of proposed rule making for a new rule, the notice shall identify two rules which the agency intends to repeal.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO REPEAL TWO RULES BE-**
4 **FORE MAKING A NEW RULE.**

5 Section 553(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
8 end;

9 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at
10 the end and inserting “; and”; and

1 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(4) in the case of a notice of proposed rule
4 making for a new rule, except in the case of a new
5 rule which is required by statute, an identification of
6 two rules that the agency intends to repeal, includ-
7 ing the date on which the agency began the rule
8 making process in order to repeal such rules.”.

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
