A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to require employees of the White House to enroll in Obamacare, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR WHITE HOUSE EMPLOYEES**

4 **TO ENROLL IN OBAMACARE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1312(d)(3)(D) of the Pa-
6 tient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law
7 111–148) is amended—

8 (1) in clause (i)—

1 (A) by striking “and congressional staff”
 2 and inserting “, congressional staff, and any
 3 White House employee”; and

4 (B) by striking “or congressional staff”
 5 and inserting “, congressional staff, or White
 6 House employee”; and

7 (2) in clause (ii), by adding at the end the fol-
 8 lowing:

9 “(III) WHITE HOUSE EM-
 10 PLOYEE.—The term ‘White House
 11 employee’ means any employee (as
 12 that term is defined in section 2105
 13 of title 5, United States Code) of the
 14 White House, including the Executive
 15 Office of the President.”.

16 (b) APPLICATION.—Any White House employee cov-
 17 ered by such section 1312(d)(3)(D) pursuant to the
 18 amendment made by subsection (a) shall, for purposes of
 19 carrying out such section, to the greatest extent prac-
 20 ticable be treated in the same manner as Members of Con-
 21 gress and congressional staff (as those terms are defined
 22 in such section).
