A BILL

 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Securing All Livestock
- 5 Equitably Act of 2017" or the "SALE Act of 2017".

3 The Packers and Stockyards Act, 1921, is amended
4 by inserting after section 317 (7 U.S.C. 217a) the fol5 lowing new section:

6 "SEC. 318. STATUTORY TRUST ESTABLISHED; DEALER.

7 "(a) Establishment.—

8 "(1) IN GENERAL.—All livestock purchased by 9 a dealer in cash sales and all inventories of, or re-10 ceivables or proceeds from, such livestock shall be 11 held by the dealer in trust for the benefit of all un-12 paid cash sellers of such livestock until full payment 13 has been received by such unpaid cash sellers.

14 "(2) EXEMPTION.—Any dealer whose average
15 annual purchases of livestock do not exceed
16 \$500,000 shall be exempt from the provisions of this
17 section.

18 "(3) EFFECT OF DISHONORED INSTRU-19 MENTS.—For purposes of determining full payment 20 under paragraph (1), a payment to an unpaid cash 21 seller shall not be considered to have been made if 22 the unpaid cash seller receives a payment instrument 23 which is dishonored.

24 "(b) ENFORCEMENT.—If a dealer fails to perform the
25 duties required by subsection (a), the Secretary shall take
26 such action as is necessary to enforce the trust.

"(c) PRESERVATION OF TRUST.—An unpaid cash
 seller shall lose the benefit of a trust under subsection (a)
 if the unpaid cash seller has not preserved the trust by
 giving written notice to the dealer involved and filing such
 notice with the Secretary—

6 "(1) within 30 days of the final date for mak7 ing a payment under section 409 in the event that
8 a payment instrument has not been received; or

9 "(2) within 15 business days after the date on 10 which the seller receives notice that the payment in-11 strument promptly presented for payment has been 12 dishonored.

"(d) NOTICE TO LIEN HOLDERS.—When a dealer receives notice under subsection (c) with respect to a trust,
the dealer shall, within 15 business days, give notice to
all persons who have recorded a security interest in, or
lien on, the livestock held in such trust.

18 "(e) CASH SALES DESCRIBED.—For the purpose of
19 this section, a cash sale means a sale in which the seller
20 does not expressly extend credit to the buyer.".
