Mr. COHEN (for himself and Mr. BRENDAN F. BOYLE of Pennsylvania) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To require the release of all records relating to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO RELEASE ASSASSINATION**
4 **RECORDS.**

5 (a) DETERMINATION.—Not later than 2 days after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President shall
7 make a determination about whether to release any assas-
8 sination record (in whole or in part) that was not released
9 on October 26, 2017.

1 (b) RECORDS RELEASED.—Those records determined
2 to be released under subsection (a) shall be released not
3 later than 2 days after such determination.

4 (c) ASSASSINATION RECORD DEFINED.—The term
5 “assassination record” has the meaning given that term
6 in section 3 of the President John F. Kennedy Assassina-
7 tion Records Collection Act of 1992 (Public Law 102–526;
8 44 U.S.C. 2107 note).

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
