A BILL

To repeal title VIII of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform
and Consumer Protection Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Financial
5 Market Freedom Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF TITLE VIII.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—Title VIII of the Dodd-Frank Wall
8 Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C.
9 5461 et seq.) is repealed, and provisions of law amended
10 by such title are restored and revived as if such title had
11 never been enacted.

12 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
13 in section 1(b) of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and
14 Consumer Protection Act is amended by striking the items
15 relating to title VIII.

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
