A BILL

To amend the Securities Act of 1933 to specify when a nationally traded security is exempt from State regulation of security offerings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Securities
 5 Exchange Regulatory Parity Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONALLY TRADED SECURITIES EXEMPTION.**

7 Section 18(b)(1) of the Securities Act of 1933 (15
 8 U.S.C. 77r(b)(1)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking subparagraph (A);

10 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

11 (A) by inserting “a security designated as
 12 qualified for trading in the national market sys-
 13 tem pursuant to section 11A(a)(2) of the Secu-
 14 rities Exchange Act of 1934 that is” before
 15 “listed”; and

16 (B) by striking “that has listing standards
 17 that the Commission determines by rule (on its
 18 own initiative or on the basis of a petition) are
 19 substantially similar to the listing standards ap-
 20 plicable to securities described in subparagraph
 21 (A)”;

22 (3) in subparagraph (C), by striking “or (B)”;

23 and

24 (4) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and
 25 (C) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively.
