Mr. WILSON of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was
referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To suspend all diplomatic presence in Cuba, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Diplomats’
5 Safety Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RECALLING OF DIPLOMATS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, not later than 30 days after the date of the
9 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall recall
10 to the United States all United States diplomats, including
11 all United States members of the Service (as such term

1 is defined in section 103 of the Foreign Service Act of
2 1980 (22 U.S.C. 3903)), who are posted at any embassy,
3 consulate, mission, or other office in Cuba.

4 (b) TERMINATION.—The application of subsection (a)
5 shall expire at the conclusion of any United States law
6 enforcement investigation relating to attacks on 17 United
7 States diplomats, and the Secretary of State, in the Sec-
8 retary's sole discretion, may thereafter assign United
9 States members of the Service to a diplomatic post, includ-
10 ing any embassy, consulate, mission, or other office, in
11 Cuba.

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
